## **GREENWALD/PREVITE HONOR GIRLS FIELD HOCKEY TEAM**

**(TRENTON)** -- The Legislature today saluted members of the Eastern High School Girls Field Hockey Team of Voorhees, Camden County, for a championship season during which they won state and regional titles.

Assemblyman Louis D. Greenwald, Assemblywoman Mary Previte and Senator John Adler (D-Cherry Hill) sponsored the joint legislative resolution to congratulate and commend the team for winning the Group IV State Championship for the fourth consecutive year.
